Urban Forest Management Planning

- This class is offered for Citrus College credit and is developed in collaboration with the California Urban Forests Council.
- This online class starts June 21, 2010 and will culminate at the MSA conference at the Pechanga Resort in October 2010.
- Cities are being encouraged to develop an Urban Forest Management Plan to improve the air quality in their community. Those cities that have an Urban Forest Management Plan increase their opportunities for receiving a CalFire grant.
- Consultants who write Urban Forest Management Plans charge between \$10,000 and \$250,000.
- You can learn to write your own plan in the new class, **Urban Forest Management Planning**. Developed in partnership with the California Urban Forest Council, Citrus College offers 3 units of college credit toward your Public Works certificate or degree. The charge for the class is \$625. Students are also required to attend the MSA Conference Oct 5-7, 2010, at Pechanga Resort. The conference fee is \$350.
