Regional Councils:

CaUFC supports seven Regional Councils across California: Bay Area, Central Coast, Inland, Los Angeles/Orange County, San Diego, Sacramento Valley, and San Joaquin Valley. The Regional Councils bring professional expertise and experience to communities throughout the state through local events which help communities develop and expand urban forests and local advocacy efforts.
