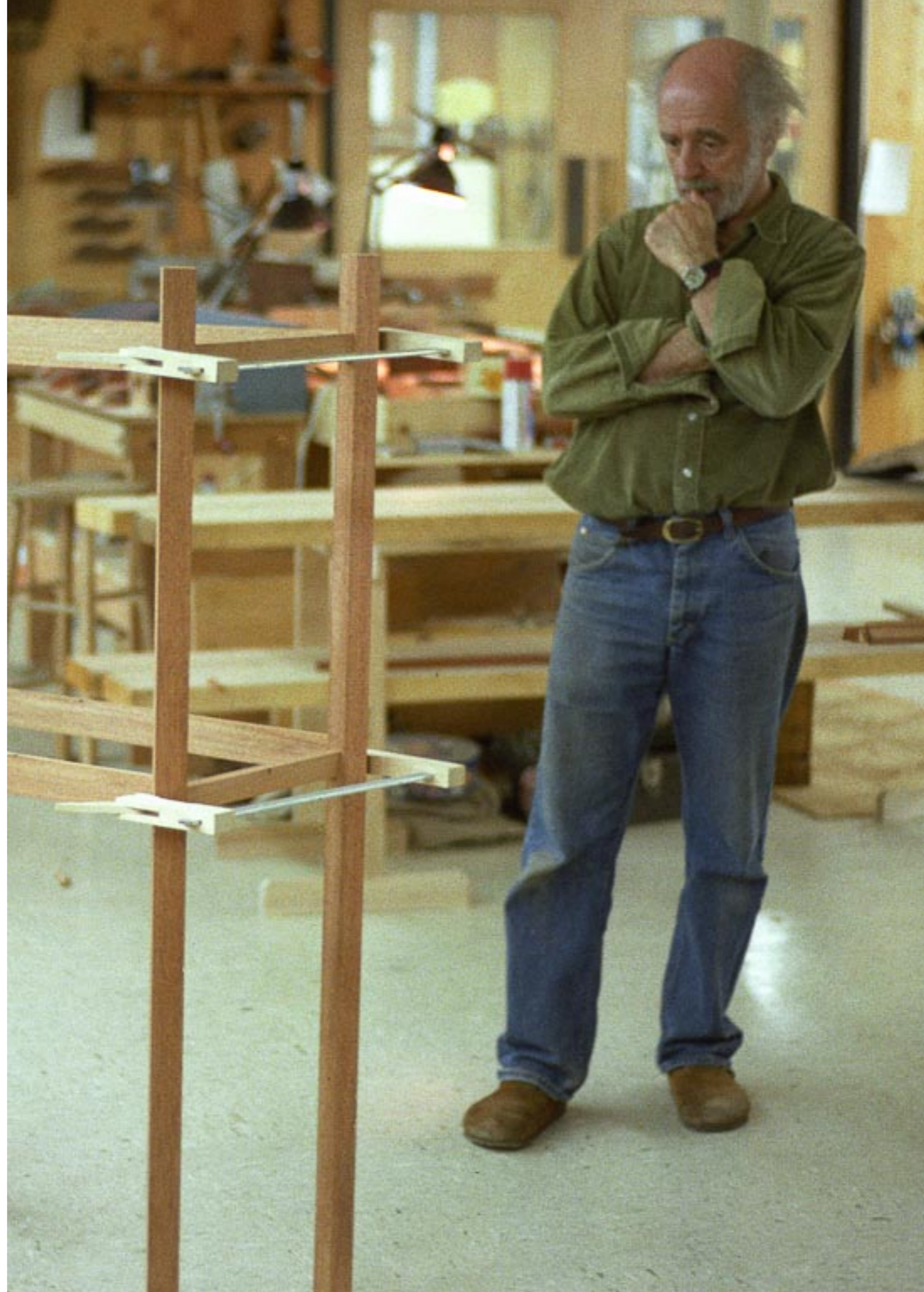

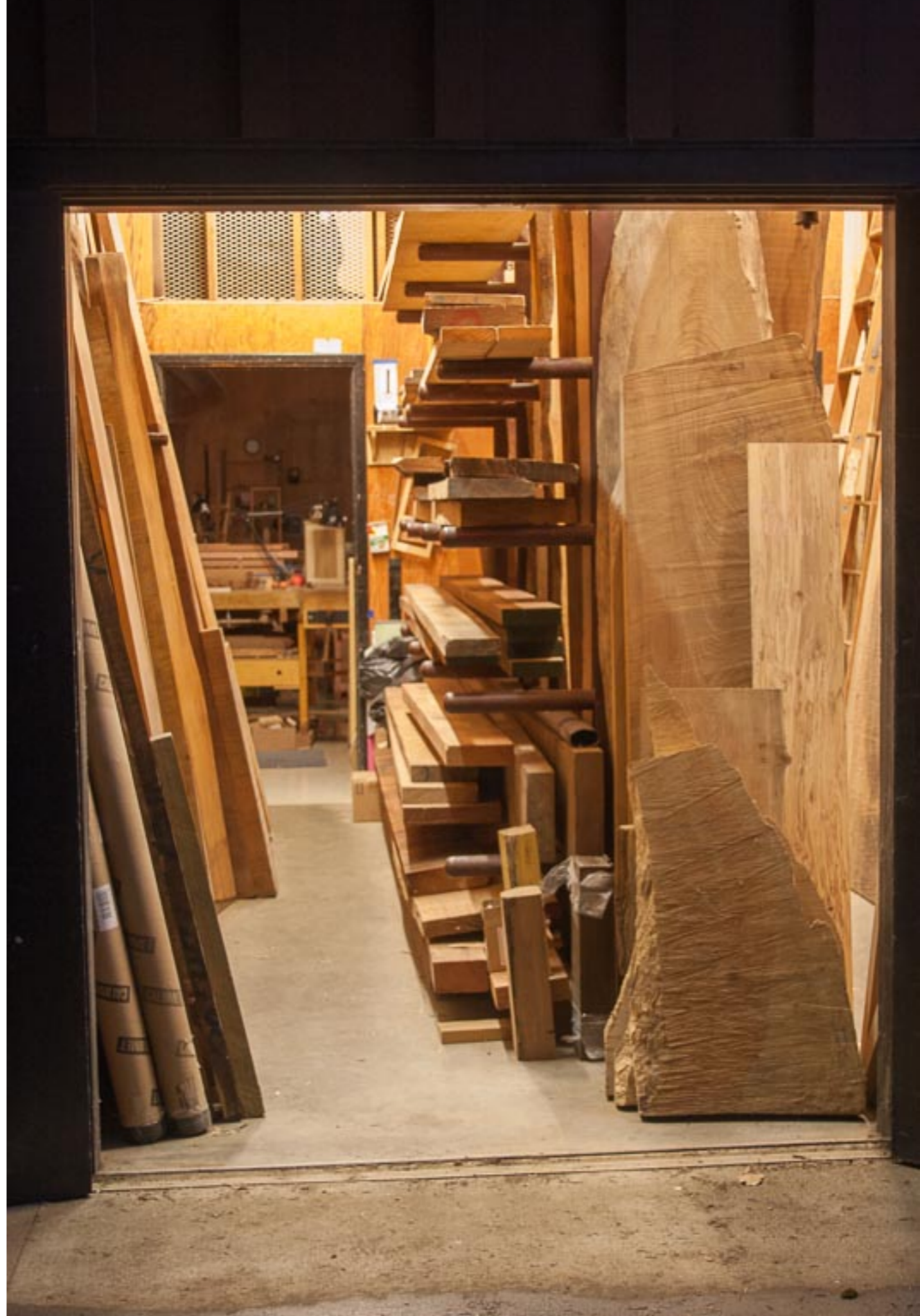










































































































# Tree Species Map for the Cabinetmaker's Zither

The three major woods used in this instrument, Sitka Spruce, Madrone and Douglas Fir are native to the Northwestern US, as shown in this map using US Forest Service data. A detailed view of the area around the C.R.F.W. woodshop (located in Fort Bragg) shows the southernmost area in which these species can be found is on the Mendocino Coast. Spalted Holly and Manzanita, small shrubs used as accent wood in the Zither, were harvested from the woods of Mendocino County.
